

**SPRING LAKE TOWNSHIP  
ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS MINUTES  
MARCH 22, 2010**

**1. Welcome and Roll Call to Order**

The annual meeting of the electors of Spring Lake Township was called to order by Supervisor John Nash at 6:00 p.m. After an introduction of the Board members it was explained that they were a part of the electors for the annual meeting. The group then pledged the flag.

**2. Approve the Minutes of the March 23, 2009 Annual Meeting**

**5. Resolution of Board Compensation**

Lou Draeger moved to accept the Supervisor Salary Resolution as presented to have the statutory salary remain at \$ 15,600.00 for the upcoming fiscal year. The motion was supported by Ron Lindquist. By a show of hands the motion carried with 42 yeas and 1 nay.

Dick Brown moved to accept the Clerk Salary Resolution as presented to have the statutory salary remain at \$ 30,000.00 for the upcoming fiscal year. The motion was supported by Beth Boyink. By a show of hands the motion carried with 42 yeas and 1 nay.

Dick Brown moved to accept the Treasurer Salary Resolution as presented to set the statutory salary at \$ 12,000.00 for the upcoming fiscal year. The motion was supported by Larry Mierle. By a show of hands the motion carried with 38 yeas and 5 nays.

Beth Boyink moved to accept the Trustee Salary Resolution as presented to keep the statutory salary at \$3,000.00 for the upcoming fiscal year. The motion was supported by Margaret Shay. By a show of hands the motion carried with 42 yeas and 1 nay.

**6. Public Comment (Questions, Comments and/or Discussion)**

Supervisor Nash opened the public comment at 6:30pm. David Rhem stood up to introduce himself as a candidate for Circuit Court Judge. There were no other comments offered. Public comment was closed at 6:35pm.
