RE: SPRING LAKE TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE UPDATE

Spring Lake Township has hired the consulting firm of Williams & Works to update the Zoning Ordinance. The Zoning Ordinance is the tool used by the Township to direct and regulate new development and redevelopment. This effort is part of the implementation strategies of the recently adopted Township Master Plan.

To help guide the process and gather input, the Township is inviting input from residents, business owners, and other stakeholders at an upcoming meeting. The meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, November 18th from 7-9:00 p.m. at Barber School, 102 Exchange Street** in the Village of Spring Lake. Refreshments will be served.

Residents will be asked to review images of development and give their opinions as to the appearance of the development. This way, new regulations can be formulated that result in development that is compatible with the desires of Township residents. The meeting will be interactive and informative.

The Zoning Ordinance updating process is expected to take approximately ten months. There is a citizen’s advisory committee that meets on a monthly basis. There will be an open house and public hearing once all updates are drafted.
