

RYCENGA PARK PARK AND SHELTER RULES

- 1. There are four park shelters which are to be reserved by going on the Spring Lake Township website at www.springlaketownship.org or by calling the Township offices at 616-842-1340. There is a charge to reserve a shelter. Refunds will not be given for cancelations made two weeks or less before the date of the event.
- 2. No vehicles are permitted in the shelters, on the grass or on the sidewalks.
- 3. No alcoholic beverages permitted.
- 4. People using the shelters are expected to clean the tables after they leave and put their trash in the trash receptacles.
- 5. No tape is to be put on the shelter posts or shelter super structure.
- 6. Do not staple anything to the tables.
- 7. No private charcoal grills can be used please use the grills provided.
- 8. Please do not use more than one electrical heating unit per electrical outlet; this will cause the circuits to overload leaving no electrical power.
- 9. No dishwashing at the drinking fountain or water spout.
- 10. The large wooden picnic tables can only be moved by park staff. If additional tables are needed for your group, please make your request in advance.
- 11. No animals in the playground area. Please make sure to pick-up after your animals.
- 12. Any damage to the park and/or park equipment will be charged to the responsible party and they will not be permitted to use the park again.
- 13. Loud music and/or disruptive behavior are not permitted.
- 14. People who use the shelters and leave an excessive mess will not be able to use the shelters in the future.
- 15. Anyone who does not follow the above listed rules will not be welcomed at the park again.
