PARK AND SHELTER RULES

1. There are four park shelters which are to be reserved by going on the Spring Lake Township website at www.springlaketownship.org or by calling the Township offices at 616-842-1340. There is a charge to reserve a shelter. Refunds will not be given for cancelations made two weeks or less before the date of the event.
2. No vehicles are permitted in the shelters, on the grass or on the sidewalks.
3. No alcoholic beverages permitted.
4. People using the shelters are expected to clean the tables after they leave and put their trash in the trash receptacles.
5. No tape is to be put on the shelter posts or shelter super structure.
6. Do not staple anything to the tables.
7. No private charcoal grills can be used – please use the grills provided.
8. Please do not use more than one electrical heating unit per electrical outlet; this will cause the circuits to overload leaving no electrical power.
9. No dishwashing at the drinking fountain or water spout.
10. The large wooden picnic tables can only be moved by park staff. If additional tables are needed for your group, please make your request in advance.
11. No animals in the playground area. Please make sure to pick-up after your animals.
12. Any damage to the park and/or park equipment will be charged to the responsible party and they will not be permitted to use the park again.
13. Loud music and/or disruptive behavior are not permitted.
14. People who use the shelters and leave an excessive mess will not be able to use the shelters in the future.
15. Anyone who does not follow the above listed rules will not be welcomed at the park again.
