At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Spring Lake Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, held at Fire Station 2, 18964 174th Ave, Spring Lake, Michigan, on the 13th day of January, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., local time.

The Supervisor stated the next order of business was the consideration of a resolution concerning the schedule of sewer rates and charges, pursuant to Section 38-255 of Chapter 38 of the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances. The following resolution was offered by Lindquist and supported by Pavick:

SEWER RATES AND CHARGES RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 38-255 of Chapter 38 of the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances allows Spring Lake Township to establish sewer rates and charges by Township Board resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board wishes to establish the sewer rates and charges attached to this resolution as Exhibit A;

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED as follows.

1. Pursuant to Section 38-255 of Chapter 38 of the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances, the sewer rates and charges attached as Exhibit A are adopted.
2. All resolutions in conflict in whole or in part with this resolution are revoked to the extent of such conflict.

EXHIBIT A

The schedule of sewer rates and charges in Section 38-255 of Chapter 38 of the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances is restated as follows, effective January 1, 2020. All references to section numbers pertain to the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances.

Sec. 38-255. Schedule of rates and charges.

The following schedule of sewer rates and charges shall be as follows unless otherwise established from time to time by resolution of the Township Board.

- (1) Connection charges and fees as referred to in section 38-243 are as follows:
 - a. The public lateral charge is \$1120.00 unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution.
 - b. The frontage charge is \$79.50 per front foot multiplied by the frontage width unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution.
 - c. The trunkage charge, per size of meter, as follows:

1.50	\$5,442.00
2.00	\$9,674.00
3.00	\$21,765.00

- (2) The interest rate and installment payment administrative charge as referred to in section 38-244 are as follows:
 - a. The interest rate is eight percent unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution.
 - b. The installment payment administrative charge is \$112.00 unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution.

- (3) The sewer usage and administration permit and inspection fee is as follows:
- a. The fee for a single-family residence is \$63.00, unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution.
 - b. All other connections are \$89.00.
- (4) The schedule of sewer rates and charges in this subsection is amended as follows, effective January 1, 2020. All references to section numbers pertain to the Spring Lake Township Code of Ordinances.
- a. Commodity charge/thousand gallons.
 1. Residential charge per 1,000 gallons of metered water based on the two preceding winter billing quarters, beginning October 1 and January 1, respectively, whichever is higher, unless otherwise established from time to time by Township Board resolution. If the premises is not connected to public water system, the charge will be based on 60,000 gallons of water use per quarter per dwelling unit.
