

Waste Pick up Procedures in Spring Lake Township

Pick up times

- 5am to 6am – Industrial, commercial and schools
- 6am to 6pm – Residential

Trash and recyclables should be out for pick up by 6am.

Items collected for full service customers

- Whatever is put out, with the exception of TVs, computers, appliances and couches
- Carpet and wood should be bundled in 4-foot lengths. Bundles should be easy for one person to lift
- Yard waste (for those paying for yard waste pickup) – leaves, grass, sticks up to 4 inches in diameter. No stumps. In the fall they will collect as many bags of leaves as a paid residential customer puts out.

Waste haulers will pick up empty paint cans or paint cans with some paint remaining if the paint has been mixed with cat litter. The paint must be mixed so the cans will not explode in the truck and have paint running out of the back of the truck onto the road.

Holiday schedules – all waste haulers move their pick up day forward one business day if your scheduled weekly pick up day falls on or after a holiday.

If a resident sees a waste hauler truck driver driving recklessly, the resident should call the police and report the truck driver's truck number.

Please note there can be differences between the provisions made by Spring Lake Township and the Village of Spring Lake regarding waste hauler agreements and procedures.
