

**Minutes of a Special Meeting of the
Spring Lake Township Board of Trustees
June 29, 2020**

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 2020 – 129, the Township of Spring Lake conducted its business via conference call to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Members of the public were encouraged to dial in to this meeting. Members of the public were not required to register or otherwise provide information to attend.

1. Call to Order/Roll Call of the Board:

Supervisor Nash called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

2. Motion by Pavick, second from Rabideau to add to the agenda the possible sale of Township property. With a roll call vote the motion passed unanimously.

3. Public Hearing on the Grand River “No Wake”

Supervisor Nash opened the public hearing at 7:07pm.

Tom Rodenhouse, 14955 Boom Rd, concerned about the 200’ from shore being limited to a small area.

Mark Ivey, 14901 Boom Rd, Is in favor of the temporary “no wake”. Mark stated that he is confused by the Board’s previous decisions concerning the matter.

Jim Douglas, 14762 Boom Rd, Supports the 200’ from the shoreline “no wake”. Would like the 1040’ of Indian Chanel to also be “no wake”.

Motion by Lindquist, second from Terpstra, to close the public hearing at 7:27pm. [RC] The motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Terpstra, second from Lindquist to approve the Resolution for Temporary Watercraft Control with the change to 250’ from 200’ from shoreline, with the length of “no wake” on Indian Chanel as mentioned in the application to the DNR requesting the changes, and to adopt the 3 points in the application as written. [RC] With Boersma as the dissenting vote, the motion carried.

4. Possible Sale of Township Property

The Township received a purchase offer of \$37,500 for a vacant lot on Hemlock by Rycenga Park. This property has been on the market for 3 years. Motion by Rabideau, second from Terpstra to approve the purchase offer as presented. [RC] The motion carried unanimously.
